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CAMPER - WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

Drop off/Pick up Information:

CAMPER DROP OFF TIME & PLACE: Check in is from 7:30am until 8:30am on the first day of your camp. Drop off is in our Lodge. Doors open for camper check-in starting at 7:30am. **No campers will be checked in early unless prior arrangements have been made.** Parent/Guardian must check their camper in at the registration table and drop off any medications with the nurse. *If you need to arrive at a different time – earlier or later than this – please contact the director or program coordinator shown above to make this arrangement ahead of time.*

CAMPER PICK UP: A Family Gathering will be held at 6:00PM on the final day, with release after ceremony – at approximately 6:45pm. Information on these Family Gatherings will be provided to each parent/guardian at drop off time on the 1st day of camp. Campers will be checked out at the end of Family Gathering and medications returned by the nurse at that time. *If you need to pick up your camper at a different time – please contact your director or program coordinator shown above to notify them.*

IMPORTANT NOTE TO PARENTS: Each camper/family is required to complete a “Camper’s Covenant of Conduct Form”. A Covenant is an agreement made between you, the camper, and the Youth Camp Advisory Board who oversee the camp. We feel this is very important to you and the camp. Please read carefully with your camper, fill out both sides, sign it and have your camper sign. Please help your camper be prepared to follow all these policies and rules for the duration of their camp. We want the camp experience to be a good one for each camper and for all our staff. Thank you!

Please BRING the following – label all items with your name if possible

MANDATORY ITEMS FOR EACH CAMPER:

- Bible
- WATER BOTTLE WITH LID FOR USE DURING DAILY ACTIVITIES!!!
- Sheets, blanket, pillow, pillowcase, bath towels, washcloths, toothbrush, toothpaste, shampoo, soap, deodorant
- Closed-toe shoes (sneakers) for hiking and sports
- Camping clothes (ex: sports clothing, hiking clothing, pajamas, etc.) – a change for each day of your camp
- Swimsuit (one-piece non-revealing or t-shirt cover for all females)
- Swim towel
- Insect Repellent
- Sunscreen
- A smile on your face with a desire to meet new friends and have a wonderful experience learning about God's great love for you

OPTIONAL:

- Stationery, postcards, stamps – so you can write home
- Flashlight
- Swim Shoes
- Pencil/Pen, Paper/Notebook (for journaling or making notes)

DO NOT BRING:

- Cell Phones, Tablets, Games, or any other electronic devices of ANY kind.
- Candy, gum or soda – these are not allowed. Appropriate snacks will be furnished by camp.
- Things to play with in the pool – safe pool items will be furnished.
- Inappropriate clothing with obscene words or pictures, or too revealing for a church environment.

If any of these items are brought to camp – they will be required to be left with the Program Coordinator or Director until camp is over.

MEDICATIONS: ALL medications - including over-the-counter medications, sunscreen and bug spray - MUST be turned in to the nurse upon arrival. These cannot be packed in the camper's luggage. Medications must be in original bottles or packaging. No one – campers or staff – can keep medication on them during camp. The nurse will keep ALL medicines during camp. A form with camper's dosing information will need to be completed and turned into the nurse with the medication at drop-off time. Your camper's medications will need to be picked up from the nurse by the parent/guardian at close of camp.

SPECIAL DIETARY NEEDS: If your camper has special dietary needs, please contact us about this prior to start of camp so we can be sure your camper has options – or – you can discuss meals with our Kitchen Coordinator as all food given is under their supervision during meal / snack times – text Darcy at 254-498-8616.
