

Camper Covenant of Conduct

Camper: Please read carefully with your parent/guardian before signing. This form signed by both camper & parent/guardian is required to be submitted with your camp registration to establish an expectation and agreement between the camper, parent/guardian and camp staff.

1. Campers are expected to participate fully in all activities of the camp. The only exception is if there are medical reasons and these must be listed on the camper's medical form.
2. Campers are expected to show respect at all times to director, counselors and camp staff while at camp. Campers are expected to follow all instructions of the camps director, counselors, and camp staff.
3. There is an established lights out time each night of camp in order to insure adequate rest and safety of all campers and staff. Campers and all staff are expected to adhere to the lights out time.
4. Campers may not have electronic devices of any kind: this includes radios, ipods, DVD players, CD players, TV's, cell phones, video games, or any kind of electronic devices that will distract the camper and others around them from enjoying God's nature and the planned activities of camp.
5. It is advised that campers leave cell phones at home, but if their parent/guardian wishes for them to bring one, it will be left with the camp director and/or program coordinator for safekeeping during the day and the camper will be allowed to make supervised calls (by director or a counselor) to family ONLY at bed time.
6. Girl's bathing suits must be either a one-piece suit that is non-revealing, or they must be totally covered by a large t-shirt during swim times. Boys swim trunks need to fit well and be non-revealing. If appropriate bathing suits are not brought to camp, camper will not be allowed to swim during swim times/water activities.
7. Illegal drugs, alcoholic beverages of any kind, tobacco products, firearms or weapons of any kind, or fireworks are not permitted at camp. If these are found in a camper's possession or belongings, their parent/guardian will be notified to pick camper up and no refunds will be made.
8. The cost of repair for any damage to property of the camp done by the camper will be the responsibility of the camper or the camper's parent/guardian.
9. Candy, gum, soda or anything sweet is not allowed in the cabins. Snacks will be provided during camp in designated dining areas. Water bottles with a lid containing water only will be allowed in cabins.
10. Inappropriate behavior between campers and/or staff is not permitted.
11. Inappropriate words, actions, jokes, or drawings of any kind are not permitted while at camp.
12. In the event a camper must be dismissed for inappropriate behavior, the Director will notify the parent/guardian to pick up the camper. No refunds will be made.
