

**JOB DESCRIPTION
Waterfront Director (Lifeguard)**

PURPOSE: To ensure the safety of all persons in and around the swimming pool.

RESPONSIBLE TO: Program Coordinator

QUALIFICATIONS:

1. Be a committed Christian with a dedication to Christ and His church
2. Be at least 18 years of age
3. Must complete a Background Check and fill out all necessary forms.
4. Have a current Basic Lifeguard or Lifeguard training certificate, standard first aid and infant, child and adult CPR certificate.
5. Be familiar with the 10/20 rule.
6. Willing to fulfill all of the responsibilities listed below
7. Have experience serving at a church camp, or a church ministry or working with children
8. Be fully committed to the staff and campers at the camp and be willing to put forth my very best effort in this position to make it the best possible experience for all involved

RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Provide a copy of current lifeguard certification to the Program Coordinator.
2. Arrive 15 minutes prior to scheduled swim times to set up & prepare for swim time.
3. Be knowledgeable of and enforce The Master's Workshop Camp Swimming Policy.
4. Test each swimmer's ability to swim before their first swim time and coordinate with the Health Officer (Nurse) to complete the Swimmers Test Results form.
5. Make sure children comply to test result bands: Red= NO Swim, Yellow=shallow only, and Green=All access to pool.
6. Prevent injury by minimizing or eliminating hazardous situations.
7. Respond quickly to all emergency situations.
8. Administer emergency first aid to victims of any accidents or injuries happening during swim times.
9. Unless an emergency occurs, the lifeguard is NOT allowed to swim or be in the pool while on duty.
